A Mighty Fortress is Our God

Congregational singing is an important part of our worship services and many of the hymns that we sing are rich with meaning. Martin Luther (1483-1546) wrote the above hymn sometime after the Protestant Reformation of which he was the originator. Luther nailed his 95 theses on the Castle Church door in Wittenberg, Germany on October 31, 1517 sparking the Reformation.

The “just shall live by faith” Luther came to understand when studying the book of Romans especially chapter 1:17 “*For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.*” This verse in connection with chapter 3:24 “Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.”

Luther had understood the “righteousness of God” to be a punishing and essential righteousness that demands we keep the whole law of God. Now he understood the “righteousness of God” as an imputed righteousness given to man as a free gift through Jesus the Christ. Luther said years later “I pondered night and day until I understood the connection between the justice of God and the sentence ‘The just shall live by faith.’ Then I grasped that the justice of God is the righteousness by which, through grace and pure mercy, God justifies us through faith. Immediately I felt that I had been reborn and that I had passed through wide open doors into paradise.”

Martin Luther had discovered the gospel afresh and from this foundational principle of salvation by grace alone through faith alone as expressed in the scriptures, he would make his stand against the errors that he saw in the church of his day. Eventually Luther was excommunicated from the Roman Catholic Church and the age of reformation was born.

Martin Luther wrote the hymn “A Mighty Fortress is Our God” which became the “marching song” of the Reformation. This hymn is based on Psalm 46 and became the battle cry of the people. It became a source of strength and inspiration for many, even for those who were martyred for their faith and convictions. This hymn has been translated into many languages and is said to have 60 translations in the English language alone. Many Lutherans stand when this hymn is sung during a church service in honor of its majestic message and its author. The

first line of this hymn is inscribed on Martin Luther’s tomb and still can be read by visitors travelling to Wittenberg, Germany today.

Here are the lyrics of this majestic hymn:

A mighty fortress is our God, A trusty Shield and Weapon, He helps us in our every need, That hath us now overtaken. The old malignant foe, E'er means us deadly woe, Deep guile and cruel might are his dread arms in fight, On earth is not his equal.

With might of ours can naught be done, Soon were our loss effected, But for us fights the Valiant One, Whom God Himself elected. Ask ye who this may be? Christ Jesus, it is He, As Lord of Hosts adored, Our only King and Lord, He holds the field forever.

Though devils all the world should fill, All watching to devour us, We tremble not, we fear no ill, They cannot overpower us. For this world's prince may still, Scowl fiercely as he will, We need not be alarmed, For he is now disarmed, One little word overthrows him.

The Word they still shall let remain, Nor any thanks have for it, He's by our side upon the plain, With His good gifts and Spirit. Take they then what they will, Life, goods, yea all, and still, Even when their worst is done, They yet have nothing won, The kingdom ours remaineth. Amen

Psalm 46:1-11 God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah. There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High. God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved: God shall help her, and that right early. The heathen raged, the kingdoms were moved: he uttered his voice, the earth melted. The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah. Come, behold the works of the LORD, what desolations he hath made in the earth. He maketh wars to cease unto the end of the earth; he breaketh the bow, and cutteth the spear in sunder; he burneth the chariot in the fire. Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth. The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah.

Instructions for Creating a Shoe Box Gift for a Child in need.

1. Use an empty shoe box (standard size, please) or a small plastic container. You can wrap the box (lid separately), but wrapping is not required. Most importantly, pray for the child who will receive your gift.

2. Determine whether your gift will be for a boy or a girl, and the child's age category: 2-4, 5-9, or 10-14. Let someone from the youth group know what age and gender and they will put a label on it.

3. Fill the box with a variety of gifts that will bring delight to a child. Use the gift ideas provided on the bottom of this page.

4. Please donate \$7 or more for each shoe box you prepare to help cover shipping and other project costs.

5. Place a rubber band around each closed shoe box and drop off at the church and the youth will bring them to a donation center.

GIFT IDEAS TO INCLUDE

TOYS: Small cares, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos jump ropes, toys that light up or make noise (with extra batteries)

SCHOOL SUPPLIES: Pens, pencils and sharpener, crayons or markers, stamps and ink pad sets, writing pads or paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books.

HYGIENE ITEMS: Toothpaste, toothbrush, mild bar soap (in a plastic bag), comb, washcloth.

OTHER: Hard candy and lollipops (please double bag all candy), mints, gum, T-shirts, socks, ball caps, sunglasses, hair clips, toy jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries).

Funeral

Violet Mary Yliniemi, 84 of Park Rapids, formerly a long time Ponsford area resident, was ushered into eternity Friday morning, Sept. 2, 2011 with her loved ones at her side.

Violet was born June 9, 1927 in Gilbert, to William and Ida (Kinnunen) Longfors. As a small child, she moved with her family to the Snellman area. She attended country school near her home. At the age of nine, Violet went to live with her grandmother and uncle where she cared for her bedridden grandma for three years. As a teenager, she ventured to Seattle with her cousins and worked for Boeing making B-17 and B-29 bombers during World War II.

She returned to Minnesota in 1947 and was married to Ervin Yliniemi Oct. 4 of that year. The young couple engaged in farming together on the Ponsford prairie. This union was blessed with four children, Geraldine, Hilda, Daniel and Kimberly.

Violet dedicated herself to making a warm and loving home for her family. She was a wonderful cook and baker who will be long remembered for her delicious Swedish meatballs, apple strudel and caramel popcorn balls. She would often work late into the night sewing dresses, coats and all other kinds of clothing for her growing children. Each spring she looked forward to planting a large vegetable garden which she would nurture into fruitful abundance to preserve for the needs of her growing family. In addition to caring for her family, Violet also worked alongside her husband in helping with the milking and other farm chores each day.

In the mid-60s, Violet went to work outside the home. She worked as a coat pattern designer for Ringer Manufacturing, she managed the Senior Dining Center in Osage and worked as a cook at the Village of the Smokey Hills. She was also talented at working with her hands and ran a furniture reupholstering business out of her home.

Her life was deeply saddened by the death of her husband, Ervin in 1977 after being married just short of 30 years.

In her spare time, Violet enjoyed quilting and sewed a lot of love into each quilt she made for her children and all her grandchildren. She was a passionate woodworker and took special pride in making all of her loved ones Christmas presents each year.

After selling the family farm in the fall of 1996, Violet moved into Osage where she enjoyed gardening and woodcarving. In 2004, she moved into the Park Villa Apartments in Park Rapids. Violet had a strong faith and was a long time member of the Spruce Grove Apostolic Lutheran Church near Wolf Lake.

Above all, Violet devoted her life to her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren who she loved

with all her heart.

Violet is survived by her children, Geraldine Weaver of Ponsford, Hilda (Larry) Sowden of Park Rapids, Daniel (Margaret) Yliniemi of Ponsford and Kimberly (Jeff) Putnam of Dassel; 15 grand-children; five step-grandchildren; 35 great-grandchildren; 15 step-great-grand children; three sisters, Lila Yliniemi of Park Rapids, Helen (Archie) Henderson of Osage and Verniel (Bob) Latto of Anchorage, Alaska; one step-brother, Elmer (Mary Jane) Bohjanen of Menahga; as well as numerous nieces, nephews, other relatives and many friends.

She was preceded in death by her parents; husband; two sisters, Mildred and Elsie; brother, Arlie; two sons-in-law, Roger Weaver and Donald Lydell and a great-grandchild, Emma.

Funeral service was 11 a.m. Monday, Sept. 5, 2011 at Spruce Grove Apostolic Lutheran Church in Wolf Lake, with Pastor Dennis Hannu officiating. Organist was Deborah Aho.
