A Season of Thanksgiving

Every November on the fourth Thursday we gather as families and eat a big dinner which typically consists of turkey, potatoes, squash, and many other dishes. We eat until we can hardly move and talk about what we are thankful for as we reflect on another year. It is a good time and usually filled with many laughs and maybe even a few stomachaches. It is a day set aside to thank our God for His abundant provisions which here in Minnesota have been truly great this year with the abundant crops and great harvest. We are thankful for this opportunity to gather with loved ones and to give thanks. Giving of thanks is a way of life for a follower of Christ as Paul says in **Colossians 2:6-7** ⁶ "As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: ⁷ Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving". When we have heard the gospel preached and received it by faith, we can believe that our sin debt has been paid and we have received the righteousness of Jesus which assures us of salvation because of His work on the cross and His glorious resurrection. Let us remember the events of His first coming, the life and ministry of Jesus on this earth and His sacrifice for us. Let us look forward to His second coming with full confidence that He will never leave us or forsake us and knowing already today we reign with Him. We have a blessed hope, a hope that is eternal.

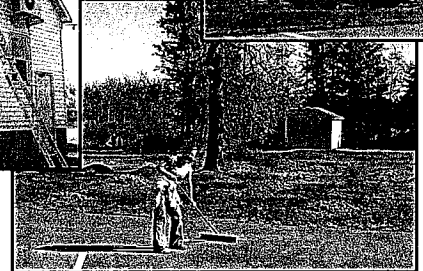
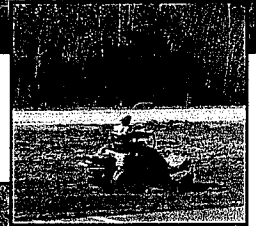
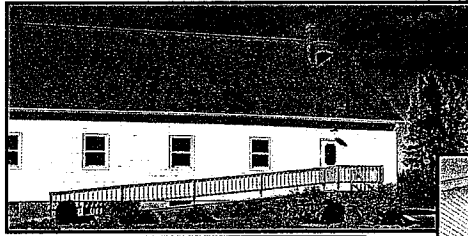
